## Regulatory Impact Analysis: Institutional Design and Methodological Approaches (OR-355)

### Course Description

Regulatory Impact Analysis (RIA) is a methodological approach that critically assesses positive and negative components of proposed and existing regulatory and non-regulatory alternatives as important elements of an evidence-based approach to policy making. The Organization for Economic and Co-operation Development (OECD) analysis shows that conducting RIA in an appropriate systematic framework underpins government capacity to ensure that regulations are efficient and effective in a changing and complex world.

This course assists policy makers, regulators, and the business community to design and implement effective analyses. By learning the RIA Roadmap, the course will use case studies, contextual evidence, and scenarios. Participants also undertake action planning and will learn how to form the legal/policy framework for RIAs and conduct RIAs in their own countries and organizations.


